

Static Judging Day Walk Through

- **Step 1:** Check-in at the Cambridge Learning Center concession windows (outside of building) on the south side. **DO NOT BRING PROJECTS TO WINDOW. KEEP PROJECTS IN VEHICLE.**
 - Sign-up when to pick up projects Saturday or Monday.
 - Will receive at check-in window: tags, string, tape, check-in number
- **Step 2:** Return to vehicle to put entry tags on projects.
- **Step 3:** Once projects have been tagged you may enter into Cambridge Learning Center through south side door where you will wait in the hallway to be called upon.
- **Step 4:** Once in the main judging room you will be called to go to the judges table you need once they are available. Once you're done with that project area judge you will take your completed projects to the kitchen window inside the judging room and return back to judges' room waiting area.
 - Seating will be provided for one parent/guardian in the kitchen area so when their child brings judged projects to kitchen window they can take to the Activities Building to put on ribbons and display.

Reminder for FOOD PROJECTS:

Youth food exhibits may only be judged on presentation and appearance at county fairs. Judges may not taste or consume the food exhibits prepared by 4-H members this summer.

Tables in between exhibitors will be sanitized. Masks are recommended but are NOT required. Please try to practice social distancing while on fair grounds
