Community Service is an important part of 4-H. We encourage 4-H'ers to give back to the community that supports them by donating their time to worthy causes. It is a challenge for everyone to find the time and energy to do community service. We would like to give them some special recognition for living up to this challenge.

The Presidents Service Challenge provides each youth with a presidential service pin to recognize their extraordinary efforts toward community support through service. To receive this award, 4-H'ers will log their community service hours and turn in their log into the Extension Office **by OCTOBER 1** each year. They will receive recognition during the Awards Program in November each year. Not all community service has to be done through the 4-H program, they can also count community service through school, church, and other youth organizations.
