GENERAL RULES

1. The intent of Chalk It Up is to raise awareness of 4-H & FFA to the public while allowing groups the opportunity to have a creative outlet in a fun competition.
2. This contest is open to all 4-H Clubs, Clover Kid Clubs, and FFA Chapter. Groups will be allowed to decorate one A Frame Chalkboard.
3. Groups must pre-register by June 15, 2020 to ensure supplies are available. Groups can pre-register by emailing Kate at Yoder@iastate.edu
4. A Frame Boards and supplies will be provided by Johnson County 4-H money. All groups will be supplied the same supplies. If your group feels additional supplies are needed, your group will need to purchase the items. Failure to return A Frame sign will result in a charge to your group for the replacement of it.
5. Groups may pick up supplies after July 1, 2020 from the Extension Office.
6. Chalk Boards will be judged on the following criteria:
 - a. Creativity and ingenuity
 - b. Ability to widely promote 4-H &/or FFA
 - c. Overall appearance
7. Each club can create their own theme for their sign. Suggested themes include: Red, White, and Blue – This Fair is for You, Join 4-H/FFA Because..., Strive for Gold, I Love 4-H/FFA Because..., etc. If your club would like to do a daily schedule on your board, please contact Kate PRIOR to be assigned times.
8. The A Frame Chalk Boards will be displayed across the fairgrounds (pending weather forecast) Use good taste when creating your board. The Extension Office reserves the right to refuse any entries based upon good taste.
9. No additional items may be attached in any way to the A frame board.
