INTERMEDIATE LEVEL AWARDS

Grades 7-9

Application requirements:

- Award application form – please check all awards applying for in “Intermediate Awards” section
- Supporting Material (up to 5 pages typed) which supports all intermediate awards you apply for.
- Written recommendation letter if applying for Citizenship & Leadership Awards

Outstanding Intermediate 4-H Member:

Recognizes an intermediate 4-H member that has excelled in the following areas:

- 4-H project achievement
- 4-H club participation – attended at least 6 hours of club meetings or club events
- 4-H communications – gave at least 2 presentations at the club or county level (any project)
- 4-H county & state participation
- Expo participation
- School and Community involvement

Intermediate Citizenship Award:

Recognizes an intermediate 4-H member who has excelled in citizenship, including service to their 4-H club/county, community, church, or school. Applicants must have a written recommendation from a non 4-H community member that attests to their involvement.

Intermediate Leadership Award:

Recognizes an intermediate 4-H member who has exhibited strong leadership abilities. Applicants must have a written recommendation from a 4-H Club leader that attests to their leadership skills and give examples of leadership at 4-H club meetings or events.
