### **Outstanding 1st Year 4-H Member:**

Recognizes a 1<sup>st</sup> year 4-H member that has excelled in the following areas:

- 4-H project achievement – completed at least 2 project records & goals
- 4-H club participation – attended at least 4-6 hours of club meetings or club events
- 4-H communications – gave at least 1 presentation at the club or county level (any project)
- 4-H county and/or state participation
- Expo participation
- School and Community Involvement

### **Outstanding Junior 4-H Member**

Recognizes a Junior 4-H member that has excelled in the following areas:

- 4-H project achievement – completed at least 2 project records & goals
- 4-H club participation – attended at least 4-6 hours of club meetings or club events
- 4-H communications – gave at least 1 presentation at the club or county level (any project)
- 4-H county and/or state participation
- Expo participation
- School and Community Involvement

### **Junior Citizenship Award:**

Recognizes a junior 4-H member who has excelled in citizenship, including service to their 4-H club/county, community, church, or school. Applicants must have a written recommendation from a non 4-H community member that attests to their involvement.

### **Junior Leadership Award:**

Recognizes a Junior 4-H member who has exhibited strong leadership abilities. Applicants must have a written recommendation from a 4-H Club leader that attests to their leadership skills and give examples of leadership at 4-H club meetings or events.

### **Outstanding Senior 4-H Member:**

Recognizes senior 4-H member that has excelled in the following areas:

- 4-H project achievement
- 4-H club participation – attended at least 4-6 hours of club meetings or club events
- 4-H communications – gave at least 1 presentation at the club or county level (any project)
- 4-H county & state participation
- Expo participation
- School, Community, and Church involvement

### **Danforth “I Dare You” Award:**

Recognizes a senior 4-H member who has completed 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade who exhibits promise in the areas of leadership, citizenship, and overall club work. This youth must exhibit personal integrity, balanced living and a potential for leadership.

William F. Danforth, founder of Ralston Purina, wrote the book "I Dare You" from his personal experience. He challenged young people to their highest potential, to aspire to attain influential lives of service and good citizenship. Mr. Danforth was one of the founders of the American Youth Foundation and he and his wife established the Danforth Foundation as a major educational and community service philanthropic institution. He was particularly interested in 4-H youth.

### **AK-SAR-BEN Award:** (4-H member must have livestock, but does not have to show at AK-SAR-BEN livestock show)

Recognizes a senior 4-H member who:

- Has been enrolled in 4-H at least 5 years
- Must be currently enrolled in beef, dairy cattle, sheep, swine, horses, goats, poultry, or rabbits
- Are making significant progress towards maturity and leadership through their service for advancement of the 4-H program in our county
- Gives evidence of leadership on club and county level
- Gives evidence of participation in county activities

### **Senior Citizenship Award:**

Recognizes a senior 4-H member who has excelled in citizenship, including service to their 4-H club/county, community, church, or school. Applicants must have a written recommendation from a non 4-H community member that attests to their involvement.

### **Senior Leadership Award:**

Recognizes a senior 4-H member who has exhibited strong leadership abilities. Applicants must have a written recommendation from a 4-H Club leader that attests to their leadership skills and give examples of leadership at 4-H club meetings or events.
