Beef Weigh-in

Saturday, December 11th, 2021 from 8:00-10:00 AM

Keoco Auction Company 603 S Warren St, Sigourney, IA 52591

- A maximum of ten calves can be weighed in for county and out of county events.
- A maximum of five calves can be shown at the Expo Fair and five at the Iowa State Fair.
- Any 4-H Bucket Bottle calves shown at the 2021 Expo Fair that are wanting to show as a Return Bucket Bottle Market or Breeding Animal needs to attend this weigh-in.
- There is no charge to weigh-in for our Expo Fair.
- State Fair scanning is \$8.00 per animal.
- Out of county costs is \$16.00 per animal for State Fair.
- There may be additional fees for tags in another county. Contact Alicia if you are attending another county's weigh-in.

*ANY PUREBRED ANIMAL SHOWING AT EXPO NEEDS TO TURN IN A COPY OF REGISTRATION TO THE EXTENSION OFFICE OR AT TIME OF WEIGH IN/ CHECK IN AT EXPO FAIR.

Anyone showing any of the following animals at the 2022 Keokuk County Expo Fair or Iowa State Fair *must* take the YQCA test.

- Coupon codes will be available from the Keokuk County Extension Office soon. The codes will be given to 4-H leaders to give out to their club members. Leaders, please check your email for a request asking for number of codes needed for your club's youth.
- ⇒ Keokuk County Farm Bureau is sponsoring part of the \$12 fee for each 4-Her to take this test. We are grateful for this continued sponsorship!
- ⇒ YQCA certifications are due to the Keokuk County Extension Office by June 1st, 2022 for all 4-H and FFA exhibitors.
- ⇒ Once you have your code from your leader, to complete YQCA:
 - 1-Go to yqca.org.
 - 2-Sign-in with either 4-HOnline or (FFA only) a new profile.
 - 3-Select the member taking the course.
 - 4-Select age of youth in 2022.
 - 5-Pay (enter code) and take course.
 - 6-Send a pdf version of your Certificate of Completion to Alicia at alschmi@iastate.edu or drop a copy off to the Keokuk County Extension Office by June 1st, 2022.
- ⇒ Coupons expire June 1st.
- ⇒ Check your certification status on 4-HOnline at https://v2.4honline.com.
- ⇒ Tests may be taken multiple times. You MUST wait 1 hour between tests. There is no face to face training.
- ⇒ Once a test is passed, you are certified until the following year.
