 - \$500 will be paid to the college of your choice at the start of the second semester of attendance.
 - Statement from college will be required stating student is in good standing and continuing in an Ag related field.
 - Awarding of the scholarship will be at Lee County Cattlemen's Annual Banquet.
 - Failure to provide documentation/claim scholarship within 6 months of award will result in forfeiture of scholarship funds.
