### **BREEDING HEIFERS**

Breeding Heifers are **NOT** a part of the verification process-yet. You will need to identify them in 4-Honline by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Purebred breeding heifers **ARE** required to have "Original" registration papers for the county fair. No Fax copies will be accepted. "Home Raised" breeding heifers must comply with the home raised rule. Breeding Heifers will need the Breed Type, Breed, Ear Tattoo number with location, and Birth date. Additionally, if you want to sign it up as Homeraised put Homeraised in the Addl. Information box.

### **BEEF PROJECT CLINICS**

Be on the lookout for upcoming beef clinics in the months of January, February, April, May, and June. The June clinic is highly recommended for **ALL** exhibitors. The new fair schedule, housing at fair, weigh-in, and more details about fair will be discussed in detail.
