



“LEASE”-A-HORSE PROGRAM

Who can Participate: Any registered 4-H member in Louisa County who is interested in learning about riding and showing horses but does not own or have access to a horse. This is NOT for 4-H’ers who have horses themselves.

About the Program: Local horse owners are matched up with 4-H’ers who sign up for the program. The horse owner will provide the horse and there will be an agreement signed between the 4-H’er and the owner. The owner will teach the 4-H’er riding showing techniques on showing the horse. The 4-H’er will be responsible for grooming the horse and learning what is needed to care for the horse in feeding and vaccinating (including chores). Timeline of Program: Sign up is open until **April 1st**. Matching with a horse owner will occur as registrations come in. First time horse 4-H participants are encouraged to sign up in early spring to receive more practice with their horse. 4-H participants will continue their horse project until Louisa County Fair in late July.
