For guaranteed printing of entry tags and a judging sheet that will be available at check-in, Clothing Event and Static Exhibits must be pre-entered in Fair Entry by July 20th.

For any projects entered after July 20th, the exhibitor is responsible for filling out an entry tag and judging sheet (blanks will be provided).



Goal Sheets

A written explanation, audio recording, or video recording is to be included as part of each exhibit.

The exhibitor should respond briefly to the following questions about the exhibit:

1. What did you plan to learn or do? (What was your exhibit goal(s)?)
2. What steps did you take to learn or do this?
3. What were the most important things you learned?

Check for additional requirements in exhibit classes for food and nutrition, photography, and visual art classes. Photography, 4-H Poster, Thrifty Meal Challenge, Clothing Event and Louisa County Horticulture Project have separate goal sheets and forms.

To answer the above questions, youth are encouraged to use the LOUISA COUNTY 4-H GOAL SHEET, available at the Extension Office or electronically at www.extension.iastate.edu/louisa/county-fair
