



Fair Tips Static Judging Day



****Don't forget to register your exhibits in Fair Entry by July 20th! Help sheets can be found online.****

Step 1: Arrive at the fairgrounds

- Unload all exhibits at the Youth Center patio. Do not park long term in front of the 4-H Building. Large exhibits—ask for help!

Step 2: Registration & Check-In

Have all exhibits pre-registered in Fair Entry?

Go to check-in table to get exhibit tags and judges sheet

or

Have some or none of your exhibits pre-registered in Fair Entry? Go to the check-in table to complete registration of exhibits.

Packing Checklist

- Exhibits
- Goal sheet for each exhibit
- Recipe cards
- 4-H Shirt
- Closed Toe Shoes
- Positive attitude

Step 3: Final Preparations

- Attach exhibit tags to the projects. Tape, string, etc. is available at the picnic tables on the patio

Step 4: Wait for Judging

- Go inside the Youth Center to get in line for judging! Take your exhibits, goal sheets, and judging form with you!
- A volunteer will help you find your judges.

Only the 4-H'er will go to the judging area to be judged. Parents may come in to take a photo and then must wait outside.

Step 5: Exhibit Judging

What questions may the judge ask?

- What were your goals?
- What did you learn while doing your exhibit?
- What is your favorite part of the exhibit?
- What was the hardest part of the exhibit?
- If you could do it again, what would you do differently?
- What do you plan on doing next year in this project area?

Step 6: After Judging ALL EXHIBITS

- Check out at the State Fair consideration table with all of your exhibits at the back of the Youth Center
- Turn in judging form to the Ribbon Tent behind the Youth Center & receive your ribbons
- Turn in photography projects at Ribbon Tent
- Attach ribbons to respective projects - including those that you may have left at the State Fair table
- Take projects that were not State Fair consideration or photos to the 4-H Building to your club booth
