Participants **MUST** wear boots or hard soled shoes at workshops - no tennis shoes allowed.

Participants must wear an approved helmet during riding events.

\*In case of inclement weather, a decision to hold the workshop will be made by 4:30 p.m. The decision will be communicated to exhibitors through an email message and posted to the "Lyon County Iowa 4-H" FaceBook & Twitter pages from the Extension Office.

Horse project members may also use the fairgrounds arena at any time with the exception of Friday evenings due to the races. Please return all equipment you utilize back to the equipment stall where you found it!

Riding at the fairgrounds on your own time is at your own risk and you cannot hold the Lyon County Extension Office or Lyon County Fair Board responsible for any accidents on the Lyon County fairgrounds/horse arena.

**While using the fairgrounds arena; PLEASE be respectful and clean up after your horses on all parts of the grounds, especially the grassy areas. ALL MANURE MUST be put in the manure pits if we want the fair board to allow us to utilize their grounds.**
