DATE

Thursday, July 18, 2024

TIME

Come-and-go anytime between 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
(with a break from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.)

LOCATION

Commercial Building at the Lyon County Fairgrounds in Rock Rapids—When you arrive, look for the white “Clover Kids” banner at the back of the building, and go to that table.

Clover Kids can bring up to three projects to the 4-H Static Exhibit Judging Day.

Examples of projects may include an art project, birdhouse, woodworking, photography, etc.

No pre-fair entry is required for Clover Kids to participate.

This is VERY informal, but a great learning experience.

GUIDELINES

- Attach a Clover Kids Static Exhibit goal card to each project. Goal cards are available on our website: www.extension.iastate.edu/lyon/clover-kids
- Make sure each piece of a project is labeled with your first and last name.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Participating should take approximately 30 minutes.
 - All participants will receive a Clover Kids ribbon.
 - Projects will be displayed in the Clover Kids booth in the 4-H Exhibit Building during the week of the Lyon County Fair from July 22-25.
 - Projects should be picked up from the Clover Kids booth on Thursday, July 25 between 8 a.m. to noon.
 - Please note that projects will be displayed in a high-traffic, public building. Our office is not responsible for missing or damaged projects.

Clover Kids may show animals in the following classes

(hamsters, guinea pigs, ferrets, chinchillas, etc.) g.) Other
(no turtles, snakes, rats or mice will be accepted).
Wildlife and livestock are not allowed.

No pre-fair entry is required for Clover Kids to participate.

GUIDELINES

- Please complete the Clover Kids Pet Show goal card and bring to the pet show along with your animal. Goal cards are available on our website:
www.extension.iastate.edu/lyon/clover-kids
- The pet must be clean and able to be handled with minimum assistance. All pets must be caged, leashed, and/or contained as appropriate.
- Clover Kids will show the audience their pet and tell a caring adult about their pet while in the Show Arena.
- Clover Kids and pets must be supervised by an adult at all times. The adult is responsible for both the Clover Kid and pet.

OTHER INFORMATION

- All participants will receive a Clover Kids ribbon.
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Goals of Clover Kids:

- To grow and learn in a non-competitive environment.
- To participate in hands-on learning opportunities.
- To teach life skills appropriate for youth in second and third grade.

Lyon County Clover Kids is for youth in second and third grade. Clover Kids is a once-a-month, after-school program that is designed for pre-4-H age kids to discover 4-H.

Clover Kids take part in hands-on activities and work on developing life skills.
