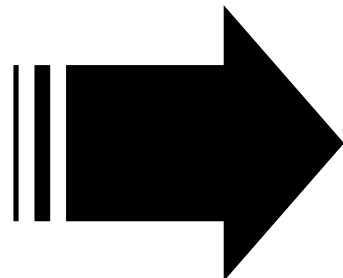

2024 Release and Consent Form

However, I acknowledge that there is the possibility of incidents.
