### **YQCA** for Livestock Exhibitors



YQCA stands for Youth for the Quality Care of Animals and is required for 4-H & FFA members exhibiting Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep, Beef, Dairy, Swine, Meat Goat, & Myotonic Goat. It is not required for Bucket/Bottle, Llama/Alpaca, or Horse project exhibitors. YQCA is an online training that can be completed at home or at the Extension office (by appointment). Cost to take the online training is \$12.00 each year. Those who complete a financial aid application at the Extension office will automatically receive a coupon code to use.

Many of you have already taken advantage of January's many snow days to complete the YQCA coursework — thank you to those of you that have!

YQCA must be completed by JULY 1 for members to be eligible to exhibit livestock at the county and/or state fair. The YQCA online program includes three components for each topic (food safety, animal wellbeing, and character development):

1) knowledge building, 2) skills lab, 3) quiz for each content topic. The online program is very interactive, bright, colorful, relatable, and fun!

### **Mahaska County 4-H Deadline Policy**

The Mahaska County Extension Council approved a new deadline policy in January 2023. 4-H members and families are encouraged to review the policy and make note of important deadlines to avoid missing them. The policy is as follows:

Every 4-H member is allowed one free pass in their 4-H career if they miss a county issued deadline. A second pass will be awarded at the cost of a \$100 late fee (this fee is in addition to any other associated fees). There will not be a third opportunity of forgiveness for a missed deadline. This exception does not apply to animal identification deadlines of February 1 (market beef), May 15 (all other animals), and any other state issued deadlines; these dates are set by Iowa 4-H and are non-negotiable. In cases of late fair entires, this exception will only be accepted if space allows for the entry.



### IF YOU HAVE AN ANIMAL YOU INTEND TO SHOW AS ADVANCED FEEDR, PLEASE LET SHANNON KNOW ASAP.

### Annual rabbit and cavy workshop March 9 in Colfax

The 4H and FFA rabbit and cavy workshop about raising rabbits and cavies will be held at the Jasper County Fairgrounds in Colfax, Iowa on Saturday March 9 from 12:30 - 4:00 pm. This workshop is sponsored by Iowa State University Extension & Outreach 4H, Iowa State Rabbit Breeders, South Central Iowa Rabbit Breeders, and Eldon C Stutsman Inc and Heinold Feeds.

There is no need to preregister and no cost (except for those youth who are purchasing rabbits or cavies and/or building a carrier and/or purchasing rabbit and cavy equipment). Youth from lowa and other states are encouraged to attend. Speakers will discuss rabbit breeds, cavy breeds, health, equipment, grooming, showing and fair information. Each family will receive a free packet of 4H and FFA rabbit and cavy information. Youth will receive free tickets for a huge drawing.

Youth are encouraged to bring their rabbits and cavies (purebred guinea pigs) and consult with speakers. Examples of rabbits and cavies will be presented and discussed. Purebred rabbits and cavies will be for sale with cash the preferred payment. A "build your rabbit or cavy carrier" session will be held with Wolfe's Animal Supply. Call to preorder for the correct carrier size by contacting Bill at 515-556-5123 or Wolferabbit3@mediacombb.net.

Rabbits can be tattooed. Cavies can be tagged. Youth need to decide on a short name or numbers for each rabbit tattoo. Youth may show their rabbits or cavies in a free "practice" rabbit and cavy show. All rabbits and cavies showing in the "practice" show are required to be earmarked with a tattoo for a rabbit or an ear tag for a cavy.

Youth may want to attend, participate and/or watch the 2024 ARBA (American Rabbit Breeders Association) open and youth sanctioned rabbit and cavy shows held at Amana Iowa on April 20 or in Colfax Iowa on June 8. More information about these and other ARBA shows will be available at this workshop.

Jasper County Fairgrounds is located in central lowa in the town of Colfax Iowa. It is east of Des Moines at exit 155. At exit 155, turn south and drive over the small bridge which is the South Skunk River and the fairgrounds will be on your right behind the cement company. Address is 359 N Walnut Street, Colfax Iowa 50054.


