

MARION COUNTY 4-H COUNTY COUNCIL MEMBER DESCRIPTION

Membership

A. Term

1. Member may serve as many times as re-elected by club or interest form is completed
2. Term begins after installation at awards dinner.
3. The County Council will consist of at least 2 members from each 4-H club.
4. Members interested in being on county council must fill out an interest form every year.
5. Area and State Council are automatically members of County Council.

B. Eligibility

1. Recommended age is 8th grade and above
2. Interest in planning and assisting in county 4-H activities and events, i.e. day camps, county fair, awards dinner and basketball tournament.
3. Willingness to volunteer time and energy to the Marion County Extension Youth Programs
4. Needs to serve on 1 committee per year.

Meetings

A. Structure

1. Meetings will be held at the Marion County Extension Office approximately 10 times per year.
2. Executive structure will include president, vice president, secretary, and reporter.
3. Two representatives or more (in order to make sure that 1-2 are at the meetings) will serve on the 4-H & Youth Committee.
4. Two representatives or more (in order to make sure that 1-2 are at the meetings) will serve on the Marion County 4-H Foundation.

Active Member status:

To be listed as an active member (county fair, awards dinner, etc.) you must complete the following minimum requirements:

1. Attend 5 regular meetings. (2 excused absence=1)
2. Help with at least three activities
3. Serve on 1 committee.
