1) Cover Page

2) Yearly 4-H Summary - A new form must be completed each year. The Yearly Summary, should include the 4-H activities you participated in for the past year within the club, county and state. Why are you in 4-H? There are spaces for you to list the project areas you learned about this year, but didn't exhibit at fair. This is also the place you list the activities you have participated in at school, church, work, etc.

3) Project Worksheets -

A) Fair Write-ups/Goals and Photo Exhibit Labels: The Fair Write-ups/Goals and Photo Exhibit Labels are only for Dyer-Hudson Exhibits. These are the forms you will take to Dyer-Hudson conference judging day with your exhibits. They will already be done for fair so all you have to do is place them in your record book.

B) Livestock Worksheets: If you have livestock you must include a 4-H Animal Project Worksheet or for Horse you must fill out a Horse Project Record form.

4) 4-H Record Keeping Self-evaluation (4H-98)- Please fill out this form and place it as the last form in your record book for the current year you are completing.

5) Pictures and Clippings - Please include pictures and clippings from activities you have participated in through out the year. Specifically the activities you mentioned in the **Yearly 4-H Summary**. ****Please include pictures of you working with your animals and completing projects.**

****Please DO NOT put your ribbons in your record book**, when you turn it in to be evaluated we do not want to take the risk of losing them. You should have written in your Yearly Summary or Project Record form the ribbons that you received, so it is not necessary to include them.**
