

General Swine Rules

Swine Show is Saturday, July 17, 2021, 8:00 AM

General Livestock Rules & General Rules and Regulations apply in this department.

Arrival and Weigh-in Times:

- 4-H/FFA swine may arrive after 6:00 PM, Tuesday, July 13, 2021
- 4-H/FFA swine must be in place by 8:00 AM, Wednesday, July 14, 2021
- Novice showmanship swine must be in place by 9:00 PM, Friday, July 16, 2021
- 4-H/FFA Swine will weigh in at 8:00 AM, Wednesday, July 14, 2021

1. Health papers will be required and must be completed within 14 days of the first day of the Central Iowa Fair. If you are planning on taking your pigs home or selling them to someone else, they must have a health paper.
2. Exhibitors in the 4-H/FFA Produce/Market/Commercial Gilt Shows must wear a 4-H/FFA shirt or a white t-shirt as stated in the General Livestock Rules.
3. Please bring your own bedding. NO STRAW is allowed.
4. Entries are made by pen space. Please be mindful when requesting pen space. You may need to bring a divider panel.
5. Following fair weighings you will be asked to turn in a form stating where pigs are going after fair so that staff can complete post fair show forms

Division 260 – Swine Showmanship

1. Showmanship Classes will be broken into three divisions: Junior, Intermediate and Senior. The senior showman will represent the swine department in the Supreme Showmanship Contest on Saturday, July 17, 2021 at 2:30 PM
2. All exhibitors must show their own animals during showmanship classes and much show in their respective grade level. No showing in a different division will be allowed.
3. Champion Senior, Intermediate, and Junior Showman will receive \$50 and a banner.
4. Reserve Champion Senior, Intermediate, and Junior Showman will receive \$25.
5. All showmanship participants must show their own animal, Novice Showmanship is the only exception.

Open Novice Swine Showmanship

1. Open Novice Showmanship is open to any exhibitor that has finished Kindergarten through 4th grade. Exhibitors do not need to be 4-H members to exhibit in this class.
2. Exhibitors are required to identify their animal on 4hOnline by May 15th, 2021. A photograph of the exhibitor with the pig must be included. The fair entry form and parental consent form are due on FairEntry.com June 15, 2021. There is no entry fee for this class.
3. Judging will be based on how the exhibitor handles their pig, cleanliness and neatness of the pig, exhibitors knowledge of the pig, and the overall relationship between the pig and the exhibitor. Parents are not allowed in the ring.
4. Health papers will be required if the pigs return home.
5. All novice showmanship pigs must be on the Central Iowa Fairgrounds by 9:00 pm, Friday July 16, 2021. They will be released at the end of the swine show.
6. Classes will be broken down by the age of the exhibitors.
7. Awards will be presented to the Champion and Reserve Champion Showman.
8. Novice showman may borrow a siblings pig to show in the Open Novice Showmanship Class.

Division 261 – Breeding Gilts

1. All breeding gilts must be tagged and identified by May 15th, 2021. Tags and tagger are available at the Marshall County Extension office. Tag number, ear notch, and color description and pictures must be entered into 4hOnline by May 15th, 2021.
2. Fair Entry: 4-H/FFA members may enter 4 breeding gilts. Entry fee is \$3.00/head. All breeding gilt entries are to be entered on FairEntry.com by June 15, 2021.
3. Breeding gilt classes will be based on weight at the fair weigh in day.
4. Breeding gilts must weigh less than 350 pounds. There is no minimum weight limit.
5. Classes will be provided for commercial and purebred breeding gilts. Class winners will compete for champion purebred breeding gilt and champion commercial gilt. We will pick a top three purebred breeding gilt, and top three commercial gilts. These six animals will then compete for top five breeding gilt.

 - b Reserve Grand Champion breeding Gilt : \$100.00
 - c. 3rd Overall Breeding Gilt: \$75.00
 - d. 4th Overall Breeding Gilt: \$50.00
 - e. 5th Overall Breeding Gilt: \$25.00
 - f. Champion Commercial Gilt \$100, Reserve Commercial Gilt \$50.00
 - g. Champion Purebred Gilt: 100.00, Reserve Purebred Gilt: \$50.00

Division 262 – Market Pigs

1. All market swine must be tagged and identified by May 15th, 2021. Tags and tagger are available at the Marshall County Extension office. Tag number, ear notch, and color description, as well as pictures must be put into 4hOnline by May 15th, 2021 and print out or on proper paperwork turned into the Extension Office.
2. **Fair Entry:** 4-H/FFA members may enter any combination of 6 market barrows and gilts. Entry fee is \$3.00/head. **All market swine entries need to be in FairEntry.com by June 15, 2021.**
3. Market swine will be shown by barrow and gilt classes. Market swine classes will be based on weight at the fair on weigh in day.
4. Barrow and gilts must weigh less than 300 pounds. There is no minimum weight.

5. Classes will be provided for purebred market hogs and crossbred market hogs. Barrows and gilts will be shown together in purebred classes. Barrows and gilts will be in separate classes. There will be a champion and reserve champion purebred market hog, champion and reserve market gilt, and champion and reserve crossbred market barrow to compete for the top five market hogs.
- a. The Grand Champion Market Hog will receive \$200.00
 - b. The Reserve Grand Champion Market Hog will receive \$100.
 - c. 3rd Overall Market Hog: \$75.00
 - d. 4th Overall Market Hog: \$50.00
 - e. 5th Overall Market Hog \$25.00
 - f. Champion Purebred Market Hog: \$100.00 | Reserve Purebred Market Hog: \$50.00
 - g. Champion Market Gilt: \$100.00 | Reserve Market Gilt: \$50.00
 - h. Champion Market Barrow \$100.00 | Reserve Market Gilt: \$50.00

Division 263 – Marshall County Derby Pigs

1. This class for commercial swine shown as Derby Swine
2. All market swine must be tagged and identified on March 27th and ID in 4-H online by May 15th to be eligible to show at the 2021 fair.
3. Fair Entry: Entry fee is \$3.00/head. All produce pig entries are to be entered on FairEntry.com by June 15, 2020.
4. Number permitting, ultra-sounding will be completed at fair
5. The champion gilt and champion borrow will show for overall Derby champion
6. Premiums will be determined by the Marshall County Pork Producers
