We are excited to announce that the new 4-H online system is now open! Here are the steps to follow to enroll for the 2020-2021 4-H year. Please be patient this year as we are all learning the new system. If you have problems please call or email Megan.

1: Go to <https://v2.4honline.com/>

- you will use the same login information you had in the past.

2: Use the [helpsheet](#) on our website to walk you through the registration process.

- You are required to select at least project area, but we encourage you to select as many as you can that you are interested in as we are trying to learn what project areas would be good to hold workshops on.

3: Payment can be made online or mailed to our office at 2608 South 2nd Street in Marshalltown. It will be \$20.00 until December 31st, after that the enrollment amount will increase to \$30.00.


On Their Own and Ok:
