ELIGIBILITY RULES:

- 1) Nominee must be a resident of Mitchell County and submit the application form by **April 1** as instructed.
- 2) Only those applicants whose parent/guardian is a member of the Corn or Soybean Association will be considered for this award.
- 3) Nominee must be planning to enroll in an accredited college or university in the fall following application.
- 4) Funds will be forwarded to the Financial Aid office of the College designated by the recipient.
- 5) Scholarships will be awarded based on quality of application. Scholarship recipients will be determined by written application process only. In the event no one qualifies for one or all scholarships, the funds will be carried over and dispensed the following year.

Criteria:

Essay	50 points
Scholarship	20 points
Leadership Activities	20 points
Recommendations	10 points

- 6) Recipients of the scholarship will be recognized and receive an award certificate at their school “Award Night” program.
