2023 O'BRIEN COUNTY FAIR CLOVER KIDS SHOW RULES

Purpose:

- A. To design a developmentally appropriate livestock project to fit the physical and maturity level of young children in K – 3rd grade.
- B. To introduce children to the health, nutrition, and environmental needs of livestock and pets.
- C. To nurture children's understanding of the livestock industry.

General Rules: (for Bottle Bucket Calves, Lambs, Goats, and Pets)

1. All K – 3rd-grade animal exhibit opportunities will be cooperative and not competitive.
2. Project is open to all O'Brien County youth in K – 3rd Grade.
3. **ALL ANIMALS** will be brought to the fair **on the day of the show** and **returned home the same day**.
4. Calves, Lambs, and Goats should be identified with ear tags – either a farm tag or one may be purchased at the Extension Office for \$1.00.
5. An exhibitor may identify up to three calves, lambs, or goats, but is limited to **only one exhibit** at the county fair. It is recommended for the welfare of the calf/lamb or goat that ideally, they be raised in groups of 2-3 head. This allows the animal the opportunity to interact with each other in a more natural production environment.
6. **All animals need to be entered by July 6th. Entry will be done online through the Google form [Clover Kid Fair Entry](#) or by submitting a Clover Kid Entry Form to the Extension Office.**
7. A participation ribbon will be awarded to all K-3 exhibitors.
8. All Rules are printed in the fair book, available online, or a paper copy from the Extension Office.
9. Children will be interviewed in the show ring and asked questions regarding:
 - a. Care & management
 - b. General health
 - c. General knowledge of the project
10. **All exhibitors must care for and show his/her own animal in partnership with a CARING ADULT!**

Bottle Bucket Calf Show Specific Rules:

1. Any calf born between February 1st and May 10th may be shown and may be a bull, steer, heifer, dairy, beef, or cross.
2. Bottle/ Bucket calf exhibitors must follow the fair's health requirements as stated in the Fair Book, this includes a 4-way shot and a certificate of Veterinary Inspection.
3. Youth will **not** be required to keep records on their calf project.

Bottle Lamb/Goat Show Specific Rules:

1. Any orphan or newborn lamb, ewe or wether, or kid, nanny, Billy or wether born between January 1- May 1 of the current project year, and in possession of the showing participant within 2 weeks of birth. No weigh-in is required.
2. Bottle lamb or goat exhibitors must follow the fair's health requirements in the fair book, including the required certificate of Veterinary Inspection, issued not more than one week prior to the fair.
3. Lambs and goats will be brought to the fair on the day of the show and returned home the same day. If you wish to have your lamb stay at the fair, you need to contact Dudley McDowell at 712-723-5290 two weeks before the fair time.

Poultry Show Specific Rules:

1. Just for FUN - for anybody in 3rd grade or under to participate in. To be judged around 12:30 p.m. during the 4-H Poultry Show. No prior entry is required, just bring your favorite poultry-type pet to the fair to show off to the judge. Cages are not provided.

Pet Show Specific Rules:

1. Clover Kids can bring one live pet. It must be entered by July 6 in Fair Entry or by using the paper Entry Form, and returned to the Office.

New! Clothing Selection Event

This event introduces Clover Kids to the 4-H Clothing Project Area! Each child will:

- Learn about personal clothing preferences (self-understanding).
- Engage in positive social interaction.
- Gain experience making decisions.

This event asks each participant to select an outfit to wear. The chosen garments can be from one’s wardrobe, borrowed, or purchased, and can be acquired from a combination of sources. After picking out an outfit they will fill out a short goal card that describes their outfit (find below). Each participant will receive a ribbon after the showcase! This event includes:

- A one-on-one conversation with a judge (static judging day, does not count towards the 3-project limit).
- An optional participation style show at the fair (more information to come)!
