Static Exhibits

Judging Day- Monday, July 15th from 9am to 11am

Clover Kids are encouraged to bring projects to Static Judging Day. Clover Kids projects will be “judged” on judging day. This is a very informal process and is more a chance for the Clover Kid to tell someone anything and EVERYTHING about their project. Judging will take approximately 10-15 minutes.

Guidelines:

- ❖ Make sure each project is labeled with your first and last name. This can be done using our Osceola County Clover Kid Exhibit Tag. We will have tags available at judging day.
- ❖ All participants will receive a Clover Kid ribbon.
- ❖ Clover Kids are allowed to be accompanied during judging!

Other Information:

- ❖ Register projects by July 10th.
- ❖ Projects will be displayed in the Clover Kids booth in the 4-H Exhibit Building during the Osceola County Fair, July 15-20.
- ❖ Projects should be picked up from the Clover Kids booth by 10am on Saturday, July 20th.
- ❖ Please note that projects will be displayed in an open building visited by the public. The Extension office is not responsible for missing or damaged projects.

Static Classes

Class A: Creative Arts- Showcase items related to art, photography, and music.

Examples: Painting, framed pictures, crafts, etc.

Class B: Agriculture and Natural Resources- Showcase items related to plants, agriculture, and the environment.

Examples: Potted plant, vegetables, etc.

Notice: If you wish to bring live plants to the fair, you will be responsible for the care of your plant(s) while they are at the fair.

Class C: Family and Consumer Sciences- Showcase items related to food, clothing, or home decorating. Swen or home-crafted items can be included in this class.

Examples: Plated cookies, tie blanket, etc.

Class D: Personal Development- Showcase items related to or created by the child.

Examples: Homemade story book, growth chart, poem, etc.

Class E: Science, Engineering, and Technology- Showcase items related to science, engineering, technology, or items designed and build by the child, such as wood structures.

Examples: Lego creation, spaghetti tower, woodworking, etc.

Class F: Animal Science- Showcase items related to animals and your involvement with them.

Class G: Other- Showcase items not included under any of the above classes.

Livestock Classes

Rabbit

Class H: Rabbit- Any gender, age, or breed.

CHECK IN: Friday, July 19th at 3:45pm

SHOW DATE: Friday, July 19th at 4:00pm

Clover Kids may bring 1 rabbit. Exhibitors will show the audience the rabbit and talk to a judge. Questions may include: name, type of rabbit, what does the rabbit eat, what is your favorite thing about rabbits, etc. All participants will receive a Clover Kids ribbon.

Note: All animal projects **MUST** arrive at the allotted check-in time and be taken home following the Clover Kids show.



Poultry

Class I: Poultry- Any gender, age, or breed of chicken, duck, or other fowl.

CHECK IN: Thursday, July 18th at 1:45pm

SHOW DATE: Thursday, July 18th at 2:00pm

Clover Kids may bring 1 poultry animal. Exhibitors will show the audience the bird and talk to a judge. Questions may include: name, type of bird, what does the bird eat, what is your favorite thing about poultry, etc. All participants will receive a Clover Kids ribbon.

Note: All animal projects **MUST** arrive at the allotted check-in time and be taken home following the Clover Kids show.



Pet

Class J: Pet- Any gender, age, or breed.

CHECK IN: Wednesday, July 17th at 3:15pm

SHOW DATE: Wednesday, July 17th at 3:30pm

Clover Kids may bring 1 rabbit. Exhibitors will show the audience their pet and talk to a judge. Questions may include: name, type of animal, what does your pet eat, what is your favorite thing about your pet, etc. All participants will receive a Clover Kids ribbon.

- ❖ Pets may include: cat, gerbils, guinea pigs, hamsters, mice, turtles, birds, dogs, and other small pets.
 - Cats and dogs must have a current rabies certificate and bring it to the Pet Show Check In.
- ❖ All pets should arrive on a leash, in a crate, cage, or bowl.
- ❖ Exhibitors are responsible for their pet and any messes it makes.
- ❖ No wild animals allowed.
- ❖ Please do not bring aggressive or skittish animals.

Note: All animal projects **MUST** arrive at the allotted check-in time and be taken home following the Clover Kids show.

Sheep

Class K: Bottle Lamb/Sheep – any breed.

CHECK IN: Thursday, July 18th at 7:15am

SHOW DATE: Thursday, July 18th at 7:30am

Clover Kids may bring 1 sheep or bottle lamb. Sheep may be any age. Exhibitors will show the audience the sheep and talk to a judge. Questions may include: name, what does the sheep eat, what is your favorite thing about sheep, etc. All participants will receive a Clover Kids ribbon.

- ❖ All sheep are to remain on a halter at all times.
- ❖ It is highly encouraged to have someone accompany the Clover Kid in the ring.

Note: All animal projects **MUST** arrive at the allotted check-in time and be taken home following the Clover Kids show.
