When/Where will these projects be judged?

- July 18 from 9AM-12PM at Trinity Lutheran Church in Sibley. (704 Poplar Drive, Sibley, IA 51249)
- Each 4-Her will talk to a judge about their project. The judge will then determine if the project will be sent to the Iowa State Fair for judging.

***Projects being sent to the state fair will stay in the extension office's possession until after the Iowa State Fair (except food). If you have something you need to fix before state fair, you will be allowed to take the project home.**





Fair Paperwork-Please bring to fair!!!

1. **Health Certificate**-Sheep can now be health checked. Swine can be health checked starting on July 12th. Make sure to call your vet to set this up. If you don't have a health certificate, you will be asked to bring your animals home.
2. **Drug Affidavit**-If showing beef or swine or have given your animal any medication between May 15th and July 24.
3. **Pullorum-Typhoid Certificate**-[FOR POULTRY ONLY](#)
4. **Swine Check In Form**-[FOR SWINE ONLY](#)
5. **Purebred Registration Papers**-[FOR SWINE ONLY](#)

This paperwork needs to be handed in in exchange for your exhibitor number.
