Health Certificates

What is a health certificate?

- A certificate that verifies any required inspections/exams, vaccines, treatments were completed by a veterinarian authorized to do the work.

Why do I need one?

- This ensures that all animals are healthy and won't spread any infections/diseases to other animals at the fair.

Who needs a health certificate?

- Any animal stepping foot on the fairgrounds for the Osceola County Fair, including dogs and small pets.

Where do I get one?

- You will need to contact your veterinarian to schedule a time for you to bring your animals in or the vet to come out and check all your animals coming to the fair.
- YOU need to contact your veterinarian for a health certificate. They WILL NOT call you.

What if I DON'T get a health certificate?

- If you don't bring a health certificate to the Osceola County Fair, you are NOT allowed to show or unload your animals. You will be asked to bring your animals home. Please bring your health certificate!!!

Swine must be health checked within 7 days of July 19.

Sheep must be health checked within 14 days of July 19.



Drug Affidavits

What is a drug affidavit?

- A form that records any drug given to any animal, especially animals that will be harvested for food.

Why do I need one?

- We need to record any drugs/medication given to animals to make sure they or the products they produce are able to enter the food chain.
- We need to have a record of medications given, especially if they need to be given at the Osceola County Fair.
- If your animal needs medication at the Osceola County Fair, one of these forms needs to be filled out, and the fair veterinarian needs to be contacted. **NO DRUG/MEDICATION IS TO BE ADMINISTERED WITHOUT THE FAIR VETERINARIANS' KNOWLEDGE.**

Who needs a drug affidavit?

- If you are showing Beef, Swine, Sheep, or Meat Goat, you need to fill out and sign the drug affidavit form, even if you haven't administered any drug/medication. You will just put "N/A" and sign.
- If you are showing any other species, and you have given any drug/medication, you will need to fill out the drug affidavit with the correct information.

You can find the drug affidavits [County Fair | Iowa State University Extension and Outreach Osceola County \(iastate.edu\)](#) here. Each species has a different drug affidavit. Please print them out, fill them out, and bring them to the fair.





What Forms Do I Need to Bring to the Fair?

1. HEALTH CERTIFICATE
2. Drug Affidavit (Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goat or other species if applicable)
3. If showing Poultry-you will need to bring your Pullorum-Typhoid Testing Form
4. If showing Swine-you will need to bring your Swine Check-In Form. This must be filled out before you come to the fair. I will send it out in an email to all swine exhibitors at the end of this month. If you don't have this form/not filled out when you weigh-in your pigs, you will be given the form and asked to go to pull your trailer to the end of the line. Your pigs will NOT be unloaded until this form is filled out.

Once I receive all this information, each exhibitor will receive their back number that is to be worn to each show. They will also receive a green dot sticker for each stall card they have. This sticker is to be put on the stall card to signify you have handed in a health certificate.



Static/Non-Livestock Info

What is Static/Non-Livestock?

- Any project that is not an animal.

What paperwork do I need for these projects?

- Each project needs a goal sheet filled out.

- July 18 from 9AM-12PM at Trinity Lutheran Church in Sibley. (704 Poplar Drive, Sibley, IA 51249)
- Each 4-Her will talk to a judge about their project. The judge will then determine if the project will be sent to the Iowa State Fair for judging.
