# *Bucket of Junk Challenge Rules*

*The Bucket of Junk Challenge is a project that should reflect your creativity! For the most part the sky is the limit on what you can do with this challenge, yet there are a few rules you will want to follow.*

- 1) The project will be completed by one 4-Her and ONE helper.**
  - 2) You may add UP TO two extra pieces not included in your bucket to finish your project– this does not include paint. Make sure to write down which two items you added to your bucket.**
  - 3) Take pictures on your progress: original junk laid out, during production, and your final project.**
  - 4) Projects can be finished anyway you would like; this includes painted.**
  - 5) Bring your finished Bucket of Junk Challenge project and the necessary paperwork to the fairgrounds on, Tuesday, July 16th between 9:00 a.m. 12:00 p.m. to be judged.**
  - 6) Bring your EMPTY bucket back with you on judging day.**
- \*If you do not use all of your junk please dispose of it. DO NOT return junk that is not used.**

**Extra tip: It's a good idea to wash the metal junk in your bucket as there may be rust or grease on some of the pieces.**
