

County Council Expectations/Guidelines

- 1.) ATTENDANCE – All members must attend at least 4 meetings and 2 events between August and May to stay on County Council. If members cannot attend a meeting or event they need to contact Julie in advance to let her know why attendance is not possible.
- 2.) LEADERSHIP – All members will give leadership to at least one fair event or county event – may include planning games, getting prizes/donations, leading/helping with a workshop, announcing for an event, etc.
- 3.) CITIZENSHIP – Members will participate in as many extra activities as possible, helping as they are able – the more the better!
- 4.) ROLE MODELS – Members will be good role models in the community and will act in a way that represents Palo Alto County 4-H in a positive manner.
- 5.) CELL PHONES – All members will turn cell phones off and have them put away during County Council meetings.
- 6.) RESPECT – All members will be respectful of Julie, other adults, and each other at all meetings and events.

Julie will keep attendance at all meetings and events. If there are members who are not acting/ participating according to the above guidelines by the May meeting, those members will be asked to withdraw their membership from the council for the next year.
