**Award Description**

...4-H members whose accomplishments reflect significant personal growth, active citizenship, earned club and community leadership, competency in project work, and unselfish service to 4-H members and others.

Achievement

...young people who have shown outstanding personal growth through participation in a variety of 4-H projects and programs.

Agriculture	...young people who have grown personally through participation in a <u>variety</u> of agriculture projects and programs.
Citizenship	...young people who have learned the meaning of citizenship and have demonstrated their understanding through good citizenship practices in all avenues of their community and their 4-H life.
Leadership	...young people who have acquired and demonstrated leadership skills and abilities in all avenues of their community and 4-H life.
AK-SAR-BEN	...a 4-H member who is making significant progress toward maturity through his/her service for the advancement of the 4-H program in the county or area.
Danforth "I Dare You" Award	...two 4-H members who have demonstrated four-fold personal development and leadership.
Galen Smith Memorial Award	...a senior 4-H member involved in County Council and who has shown an interest in youth via camp counseling or other support
Noah Flaherty Memorial Award	...a senior 4-H member involved in County Council and who has shown an understanding and has demonstrated the importance of community service and civic involvement
Jeanette Anthe & R.W. Ashby Outstanding 4-Her Awards	...a 4-H member who has excelled in leadership, service to 4-H, church, and community, and in his or her unselfish concern for other people.
