

PLYMOUTH COUNTY FAIR KING CONTEST
PLYMOUTH COUNTY FAIR JULY 24-28

1. Each contestant must be at least 16 years of age and not more than 21 years of age on July 24, the first day of the Plymouth County Fair.
2. Contestants must be unmarried and must never have been married.
3. A county fair king must belong to a club or FFA organization in Plymouth County. The king may not represent another county or state.
4. Each contestant must be an active member of 4-H, which includes **meeting the attendance policy of their local 4-H club**, or a representative of FFA.
5. A copy of the minutes from the club meeting where the contestant was nominated must accompany entry form. Leaders/Advisors need to sign the entry form.
6. Each county fair king contestant is to send an original wallet size photograph of himself with his entry blank. No scanned or emailed photos.
7. Candidates will be selected by a competent panel of judges.
 - a. Composure and confidence
 - b. Personality, Attitude, Appearance and Awareness
 - c. Leadership and Citizenship - contribution to community
 - d. Over-all impression
8. Each contestant is to appear in dress pants, a collared-button down shirt, and tie for judging and crowning. Royalty t-shirts will be given to the contestants to wear on the outing, parades, and other appearances. These shirts will be worn with khaki shorts or pants. Once a court is crowned, the court will wear the polo shirt or court t-shirt provided to them with dress pants/shorts or nice jeans or at all future appearances.
9. The winner of the county will be asked to appear for the Plymouth County Fair Board in official capacities as requested throughout the year until his successor is crowned. Be aware that you will be expected to be present at the fair and attend many events to introduce yourself. If you are showing animals or are engaged in another duty, your fellow court will make the introduction. Please make arrangements with family to help with care of your animals so you can be present.
10. Should the 2024 Plymouth County Fair King marry or become **ineligible** before the 2025 King is crowned, he will forfeit his crown and title.
11. The Plymouth County Fair King Contest Committee and the Plymouth County Fair Board reserves the right to change the foregoing rules and regulations at any time as may be deemed expedient.
