PLYMOUTH COUNTY FAIR QUEEN CONTEST PLYMOUTH COUNTY FAIR JULY 24 - 28, 2024

- 1. Each contestant must be at least 16 years of age and not more than 21 years of age on August 8, the first day of the 2024 Iowa State Fair.
- 2. Contestants must be unmarried and must never have been married.
- 3. A county fair queen must be a member of a 4-H club or FFA chapter in Plymouth County.
- 4. Each contestant must be an active member of 4-H, which includes meeting the attendance policy of their local 4-H club, or a representative of F.F.A.
- 5. A copy of the minutes from the club meeting where the contestant was nominated must accompany entry form. Leaders need to sign entry form.
- 6. Each entrant in the State Fair contest must be selected in a competitive queen contest at her county fair.
- 7. Only the county fair winner will be eligible to represent her county at the lowa State Fair contest. (Alternates will be considered in order of selection in event queen candidate is unable to participate.)
- 8. No professional model is eligible for the State Fair contest. (A professional model can be defined as one who has been employed and paid a salary for a specific job of modeling.)
- 9. Any contestant who has competed at a State Fair finals may not compete again.
- 10. Any county fair queen selected after the 2023 State Fair and meeting the above qualifications is eligible for the 2024 contest.
- 11. Each county fair queen contestant is to send a billfold size photograph of herself with her entry form. The county fair queen will be required to send an 8 x 10 photo to the Secretary, Iowa State Fair in order that it can be a part of the State Fair Queen Display at the Iowa State Fair.
- 12. At the Plymouth County Fair and at the Iowa State Fair, queens will be selected by a competent committee.
 - a. Beauty, charm and poise
 - b. Personality, Attitude, Appearance and Awareness
 - c. Leadership and Citizenship contribution to community
 - d. Over-all appearance
- 13. Each contestant is to appear in an evening gown.
- 14. The winner of the county must also agree to appear for the Plymouth County Fair Board in official capacities as requested throughout the year until her successor is crowned.
- 15. Should the 2024 Plymouth County Fair Queen marry or become **ineligible** before the 2025 Queen is crowned, she will forfeit her title and the crown.
- 16. The Plymouth County Fair Queen Contest Committee and the Plymouth County Fair Board reserves the right to change the foregoing rules and regulations at any time as may be deemed expedient.
- 17. If selected as Plymouth County Fair Queen, the Iowa State Fair Queen Committee states that you must be fully committed to participate in all activities associated with the Iowa State Fair Queen competition during the Iowa State Fair.
