

Entering Market/Weigh-In Animals in 4-H Online

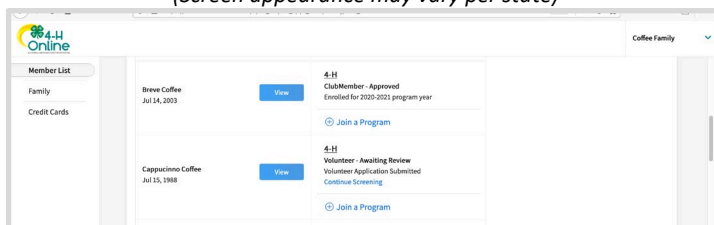
AGAIN FOR 2024: 4-H Families will enter the Market Beef Weigh-In Data this year into 4-H Online

- **ALL Market Beef data MUST be entered by families by February 1**
- **County 4-H Staff will review the weigh-in data for accuracy**
- **Ultimate animal data accuracy rests with each 4-H Family**

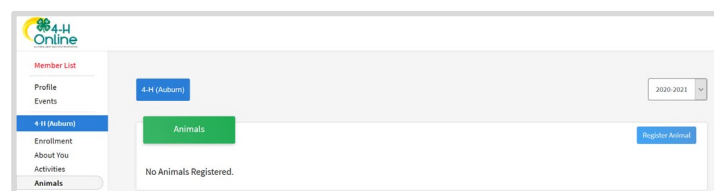
Steps

1. Log in to your family account.
2. Click to View the Member's record for whom you would like to add an animal.

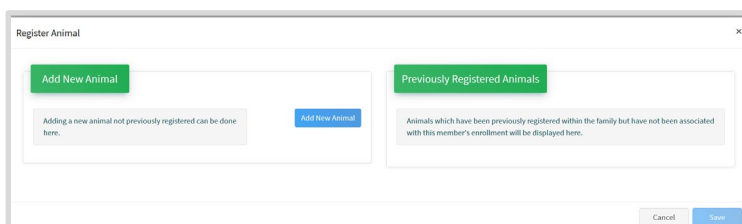
(Screen appearance may vary per state)



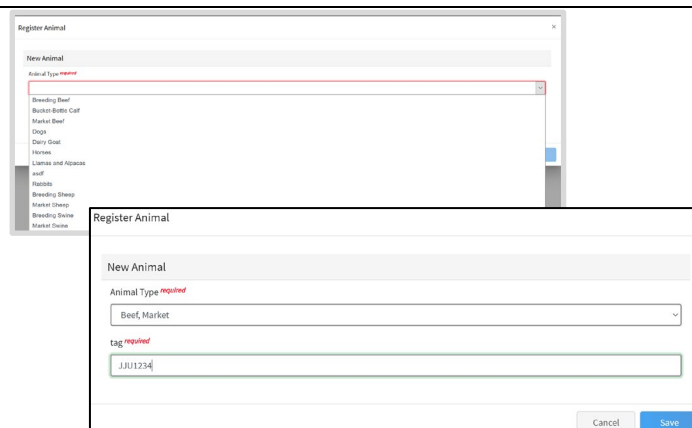
3. Click Animals in the navigation pane.
4. Click the blue Register Animal button.







5. Click Add New Animal to start adding a new animal.



6. Select the appropriate animal type from the drop-down menu.
7. For market beef, select the "Beef, Market" animal type
8. Enter the required Tag.
9. **Be sure to CORRECTLY enter the Ear Tag #:**
 - See examples on the next page.
10. Click Save.

<p>14. Upload any required or optional files for this animal.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This could include pictures of the animal, etc. • These file instructions are set up by county and/or state 4-H staff, if needed <p>15. Click the Next button</p>	
<p>16. Review the entered information. Use the Back button at the bottom of the page to return to the previous screen to make corrections.</p>


17. Once the entered information is correct and reviewed, click the Submit button.
