

Pocahontas County 4-H Scholarship

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. The ISU Extension Council will award up to ten scholarships in the amount(s) of \$500 or \$1000 to senior students enrolled in Pocahontas County 4-H.
- 2. Scholarships winners are selected by an unbiased committee appointed by the Council.
- 3. Recipients will be notified by the committee and will be presented the scholarship at thier school's senior award ceremony.
- 4. The scholarship will be awarded the second semester of your freshman year in college. Payment will be sent directly to the college.
- 5. In the event the recipient does not use the said scholarship because of withdrawal from school or any other reason the first year, the amount shall revert to the donors.
- 6. Applicants must attend an accredited college, university, vocational technical school or apprentice program.

APPLYING FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Applicants must submit the completed application on the following three pages.
- 2. Application should be filled out electronically and completed. Save PDF to your computer before filling out application. Open PDF document from your computer then complete.
- 3. Applicants must submit most recent grade transcript (seven semesters).
- 4. Two letters of recommendation must accompany the scholarship application. One letter should be from your current 4-H leader (may be a past leader if you have had a new leader in the past two years) and one letter from a school faculty member. Letters must be sealed with the author's signature across the sealed back of the envelope.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Application and supporting material must be in to the Pocahontas County Iowa State University Extension and Outreach Office by 4:30 p.m. February 1, 2024.

No late applications will be accepted.
