Fair Entry

You will need to go into FairEntry and enter EVERYTHING you would like to exhibit at the Pocahontas County Fair. **Livestock entry is due no later than June 22** and static exhibits should be entered no later than July 16. The program has been updated again this year so if you have any trouble please call the office 712-335-3103. There will not be any bedding fees again this year, **static exhibit fee AND livestock fees will be taken out of your premium**, so you will not need to pay for static exhibits or livestock. You will use your 4HOnline email and password to make fair entry.

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA)

All 4-H and FFA members that will exhibit ANY LIVESTOCK (except companion animals-dog, horse, pet) will be required to be YQCA certified, this is in place of FSQA. Each year the 4-H'ers will be required to take the web-based YQCA. The fee for the program is \$12, and will be paid for out of 4-H funds. If you lose your coupon code you will not be issued a new one and you will need to pay the \$12 yourself. YQCA may be taken at any time, but **MUST BE COMPLETED BY JULY 1** to exhibit at 2018 fair.

NEW Coop Feed Mill Tour

All 4-H'ers are invited to tour the NEW Coop Feed Mill in Pomeroy on Thursday, June 14. 4-H'ers in the Swine Challenge may count this tour as one of their educational requirements. All other 4-H'ers are encouraged to attend and see how this modern feed mill processes livestock feed. **ADULTS** we will need adult chaperones for this event, we would like no more than 5 children/adult. If you are bringing your child to the event please plan on staying and going through the tour with your child. There is no fee to attend, but we do need to know by June 8 how many will be attending.
