Each year the lowa Dairy Goat Association promotes interest in dairy goats across our state. One of the ways IDGA encourages young people to explore dairy goats is through its Share-A-Kid program. This statewide contest is open to youth in 4<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grades and are a member of 4-H, FFA, IDGA, or any other agricultural group. Winning applicants are selected from an essay they submit. The essay can include drawings, photos, or any other creative touches.

IDGA can only award one goat per family per year; however, siblings are encouraged to apply. Previous winners are ineligible. # Youth For the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA)

Everyone's certification will expire before the 2023 fair! This is a required certification for all youth who exhibit the following animals at the county or state fair. Certification must be completed by July 1.

- Cattle- Breeding, Market & Dairy
- Swine- Breeding & Market
- Sheep- Breeding & Market
- **Training Options for 2023 Fair Season:**

Online YQCA class option for all age levels (Certification is good for 1 year)

- The online option costs \$12 per youth payable online only! Via https://yqcaprogram.org/
- Youth must pass 3 quizzes with a score of 80% or above. If youth do not pass, they must wait 1 hour before retaking the quiz (without additional fees). This can be done as many times as necessary.
