Youth For the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA)

Everyone's certification will expire before the 2023 fair! This is a required certification for all youth who exhibit the following animals at the county or state fair. Certification must be completed by July 1.

- Cattle- Breeding, Market & Dairy
- Swine- Breeding & Market
- Sheep- Breeding & Market

- Goats- Breeding, Market & Dairy
- Poultry
- Rabbits

Training Options for 2023 Fair Season:

Online YQCA class option for all age levels (Certification is good for 1 year)

- The online option costs \$12 per youth payable online only! Via https://yqcaprogram.org/
- Youth must pass 3 quizzes with a score of 80% or above. If youth do not pass, they must wait 1 hour before retaking the quiz (without additional fees). This can be done as many times as necessary.

Face to Face class options (Certification is good for 1 year):

- The cost is \$3 per youth—payable online only!
