## Renew your Epsilon Sigma Phi Membership Through 2020

ESP members can renew their membership and manage their account profile in the national database online. The process is very quick for those renewing. If you prefer to use a help guide, visit our Alpha Mu Chapter website to download the help sheet.

Remember, your continued membership benefits YOU by increasing your professional value. Members are encouraged to explore opportunities in leadership and professional development. Benefits include scholarships to attend national conferences, access to webinars, networking and scholarly activities.

To begin, members should go to: https://epsilonsigmaphi.wildapricot.org/

Start with the Login button in the upper right hand corner. You'll login using your IASTATE email address and the ESP password. After successfully logging in, you may need to click on your name in the upper right hand corner to access your profile and renewal information.

Renewing members will click on the "Renew to 02/01/2020" button. Next you will be given an opportunity to update your profile information. Iowa members will pay \$40 of national dues and \$20 of chapter dues. To pay by credit card, simply click on the "Pay Online" button. To pay by check, press the button to generate an invoice and follow the instructions for sending a check.
