Record Book and Award Information

Record books are a great way to look back and see all of the projects you have done through out 4-H! Below is a guide for how to start your record books! 4-H yearly summary and Project award sheets can be found here: 4-H Record Keeping Forms | Poweshiek County (iastate.edu)

Record Books will be due Monday, October 20th to the Extension Office!

Their will be \$10- \$15 dollar premium for record books that meet certain criteria

Organizing your Record Book:

Title Page

Include your name, age, grade last completed, club, number of years you have been in 4-H and a photo of yourself.

4-H Yearly Summary

This is your opportunity to showcase everything you have done throughout the year. You should have one every 4-H year you have completed, starting with the most recent year. Please remember, this is more than just your County Fair exhibits! Did you do a presentation at your club? Attend a workshop? Etc.

Project Records

If you would like to apply for a project award, you must complete a project record. Project forms can be found at our website. You need to complete 1 per species or project. 4-H Record Keeping Forms | Poweshiek County (iastate.edu)

Clover Kids

The 2023-2024 school year is quickly approaching which means that Afterschool Clover Kids registration will be opening soon!

What is Clover Kids?:

Clover Kids is a fun 4-H program specifically designed for children in kindergarten through third grade. The overall purpose of the Iowa 4-H Clover Kids program is to foster the development of life skills that are essential for the cognitive, social, emotional, and physical maturation of kindergarten through third graders by providing a unique, age-appropriate educational opportunity. In order to provide a high quality learning experience, the Clover Kids program is designed to be continuous and long-term. For this reason, Clover Kids groups meet on a regular basis (x1 per month).

What do Clover Kids do?:

Investigate Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM), explore literacy through fun and engaging ways to read and write, learn the importance of being healthy and physically active, practice communication skills and learn to work as a team, play fun cooperative games and make new friends, participate in developmentally appropriate opportunities at County Fair, and much, much more!!

How can my child become a Clover Kid?:

Soon, afterschool Clover Kid registration forms will be available at the Poweshiek County Extension Office or the School Offices at Montezuma Elementary, Baily Park Elementary, Fairview Elementary, and BGM Elementary schools. In addition registration forms will be published on the Poweshiek County Extension website and social media pages.
