# Event Day - June 8, 2024

Event Day gives Clover Kids an opportunity to tell others about and show off their 4-H projects and/or demonstrate their talents and abilities. Food Challenges, Clothing Challenges, and Presentations are judged and awarded ribbons. Below you will find descriptions of the various Event Day challenges that Poweshiek County Clover Kid youth can participate in.

The 2024 Event Day will be held at the Grinnell United Methodist Church (916 5th Ave, in Grinnell) on June 8, 2024. Register for Event Day by visiting [Fair Entry](#) and logging in with 4-H Online. Registrations due by June 6, 2024. Once all entries are made a schedule will be created, with each event having a 15 minute time slot.

Participants should fill out an Event Day Goal Form and bring it with them to Event Day. Event Day Goal Forms can be found on the [Poweshiek County Clover Kids website](#).

## FOOD CHALLENGES

### Food Challenge

Clover Kids select a food item that they have learned to prepare in the past year. They will have 15 minutes to prepare it in front of a judge. The judge will consider proper food preparation, techniques, safe food/handling, skill level, and the final product.

#### Possible ideas:

Peanut Butter and Jelly Sandwich, Dirt Cups, Fruit Smoothie, Kabobs (fruit, cheese, and meat), Trail Mix, Yogurt Parfait, Grilled Cheese Sandwich, Puppy Chow, Vegetable Dip

These are just some ideas. Be creative!

### Table Setting

Clover Kids may work alone or in a team to create a themed table setting. Table setting should include a menu (no food), proper table service, glassware, and themed decorations.

Clover Kids are even encouraged to dress in accordance with your theme. Be creative!

## CLOTHING CHALLENGES

### Clothing Selection

Clover Kid will select and/or purchase an outfit that represents their goal or intended use for the selected outfit.

Clover Kid can purchase a garment or put something together that they already have in their closet.

### \$20 Challenge

Clover Kid can purchase a garment at a garage sale, consignment store, or resale shop. Hand-me-downs would belong in Clothing Selection, not the \$20 Challenge category.

Cost of the outfit must be \$20 or less, not including shoes, accessories, or undergarments. Receipts must be turned in with Clothing Event Report Form.

## COMMUNICATION CHALLENGES

### Educational Presentation

**Informative presentation or how to demonstration** - Share what you have learned either at a Clover Kids session, in school, at a field trip, or from a parent.

Some examples include: "How to Sew on a Button," "My Family Vacation/Facts on a State," Facts About My Favorite Animal."

**This event is for 3rd graders only.**

### Working Exhibits

A hands on activity engaging the audience to learn a new skill. You are evaluated on how well you encourage the audience to participate.

Some examples include: making a beaded bracelet, making a paper airplane, and making bookmarks.

**This event is for 2nd and 3rd graders only.**

### Share the Fun

Have some fun and show off your talent! You could sing, play an instrument, do a magic trick, or tell a joke. Be creative!

To make it easier, partner up with other Clover Kids and present a talent together!

## Indoor (Static) Exhibits - July 13, 2024

This is your Clover Kid's opportunity to show off something they've created or done. It could be an informative poster, a cookie they baked, a picture frame they decorated, a craft they made, something they drew, or something they take care of. The possibilities are endless! Below you will find descriptions of the various Indoor Static Exhibits that Poweshiek County Clover Kid youth can participate in.

## SMALL PET PROJECT

Clover Kids will talk to an adult volunteer about their pet. Clover Kids should be prepared to talk about where the pet lives, what they eat, and how they care for the pet.

The pet could be a dog, cat, rabbit, guinea pig, etc.

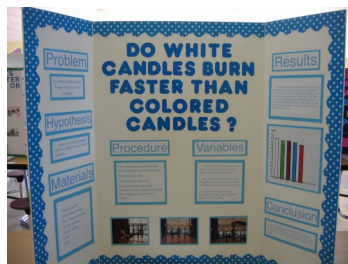

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**Note:** All poultry must attend Poultry Pullorum Testing on Thursday, July 11th from 2:00-4:00 pm at the Grinnell Vet Clinic

Clover Kid livestock **MUST** be housed at the fairgrounds throughout the duration of the fair.

Livestock may arrive at the fairgrounds on **Tuesday, July 16, 2024 from 5:00 –8:00 pm.**

Register for Livestock Showing by:

- Enter animal identification information on [4-H Online](#) by May 15, 2024
- If applicable: Fill out and turn in a Bottle Calf, Lamb, and Goat ID Form to the Extension Office by May 15, 2024. Bottle Calf, Lamb, and Goat ID Forms can be found on the [Poweshiek County Clover Kids website](#).
- All livestock participants should fill out a Livestock Goal Form and bring it with them to their livestock show. Livestock Goal Forms can be found on the [Poweshiek County Clover Kids website](#).
- While showing, Clover Kids must be prepared to exhibit an animal that is clean and neat, handle the animal with minimal assistance, and keep the animal between themselves and the judge.
