4-H & Clover Kid Club Requirements

Just a reminder all clubs must have the following:

- 5 youth from at least 3 different families
- Have an identified approved leader
- Meet at least 6 times a year.



Beef Weigh-In- Dec. 10th from 1-3pm

When: Saturday, December 10th-1pm-3pm; snow date Dec. 11th

Where: Grinnell Vet Clinic | 1631 West St (south on HWY 146) (Please turn around in airport road and use it as a waiting area)

What: All market beef animals being shown at the Poweshiek County and/or Iowa State Fair must be weighed in and tagged. This includes second year market bottle calves and production beef (animals harvested at Dayton's in July). If your second year bottle calves need to be retagged, we can do this at this time.

General Information: Participants must be enrolled in 4-H Online AND pay their \$35 annual enrollment fee prior to weigh-in.

State Fair Information: Retinal images will be collected for all animals that may possibly be exhibited at the State Fair.

After Weigh-in: Like last year, you will be responsible for putting the information online into 4-H Online. We will have instructions printed out for you at the weigh-ins.

Note: Please plan to attend our county's weigh-in. If for some reason you are unable to attend, you need to contact the Poweshiek County Extension Office at 641-623-5188 or emailing xpoweshiek@iastate.edu to make other arrangements.

CWF Trip

lowa 4-H is planning to offer Citizenship Washington Focus for teens who have completed grades 9-12. Trip dates are June 17-24, 2023. The week will be full of workshops with 4-H teens from around the country and sightseeing in the Washington, DC area. Cost for teens will be \$2,300 per person. A minimum of 3 adult chaperones will be needed. Chaperone cost is discounted to \$1,300 per person. We are updating the lowa 4-H CWF website, and registration will be open by December 15. There is a minimum number of 32 teens, with a maximum of 48 to make this trip cashflow.

Objectives for the program are:

- Strengthen communication, leadership, and other citizenship skills on a national level
- Understand the importance of civic and social responsibilities as they relate to the development of better citizens and leaders
- Exchange ideas, practice respect, and form friendships with other youth from diverse backgrounds
- Experience hands-on learning using the historical backdrop of our nation's capital city, Washington, D.C.

These objectives are met through pre-trip education, speakers, workshops, daily excursions to view national sites, a day at the Capitol with elected officials, and a delegate designed and implemented action plan.

National 4-H Youth Summit

March 9-12, 2023 in Washington D.C.

At the National 4-H Youth Summit on Healthy Living, Photography, and Agri-Science, high school students develop the skills and knowledge needed for the challenges facing agriculture, food security, and sustainability. Students will work with each other and experts in the agricultural community in this collaborative, hands-on educational setting.


