4-H Beef Weigh In

The 4-H Beef Weigh In will take place on **Saturday**, **December 9th from 1pm-3pm** at the Grinnell Vet Clinic (1631 West St in Grinnell).

All market beef animals being shown at the Poweshiek County Fair and/or Iowa State Fair must be weighed in and tagged! This includes second year market bottle calves and production beef. If you are unsure about attending the weigh in, please call or email us.

Cost (cash or check collected at weigh in):

- * \$3 per beef tag
- * \$5 per retinal image must be collected for all animals that may be exhibited at the State Fair

4-H'ers **MUST** be enrolled in 4-H Online **AND** pay their \$35 membership fee **PRIOR** to weigh-in.

Like last year, you will be responsible for putting the identification information into 4-H online. Extension will provide printed identification instructions for you at the weigh-in.

4-H Information

2023-2024 4-H/Clover Kid Enrollment

Each year, all new and returning 4-H'ers and Clover Kids must enroll via <u>4-H Online</u> and pay a registration fee to become an official 4-H or Clover Kid member.

Poweshiek County Membership Dues are as follows:

- Community 4-H Club: \$35 (unless otherwise stated)
- Community Clover Kids Club: \$5
- After-School Clover Kids: \$40



This year, all across Iowa 4-H membership dues rose \$10. The membership for Iowa 4-H is now \$45. However, Poweshiek County 4-H membership dues will NOT increase this year. A huge thank you to Glen and Ginger Sterk who have graciously offered to cover the \$10 increase for every Poweshiek County 4-H and Clover Kid member this year!

To continue receiving 4-H information, re-enrollment must be completed by December 15th, 2023.
