Record Book and Award Information

Record books are a great way to look back and see all of the projects you have done through out 4-H! Below is a guide for how to start your record books! 4-H yearly summary and Project award sheets can be found here: 4-H Record Keeping Forms | Poweshiek County (iastate.edu)

Record Books will be due Monday, October 3rd to the Extension Office!

Organizing your Record Book:

Title Page

Include your name, age, grade last completed, club, number of years you have been in 4-H and a photo of yourself.

4-H Yearly Summary

This is your opportunity to showcase everything you have done throughout the year. You should have one every 4-H year you have completed, starting with the most recent year. Please remember, this is more than just your County Fair exhibits! Did you do a presentation at your club? Attend a workshop? Etc.

Project Records

If you would like to apply for a project award, you must complete a project record. Project forms can be found at our website. You need to complete 1 per species or project. 4-H Record Keeping Forms | Poweshiek County (iastate.edu)

Need help or have questions about organizing your Record Book? Join us for either workshop. Come as long as you need. Please sign up on 4-H Online or call the office to let us know you plan on attending a workshop.

Completing your record book will be easy if you follow this guide and reference the forms found at: 4-H Record Keeping Forms | Poweshiek County (iastate.edu)



Outside Cover & Title Page: Introducing yourself

- -Outside cover: Name and club
- -Title page: Name, Age, Grade Completed, Club, & Picture



Yearly Summary: "Overall" record of what you did in 4-H This Year

- -Page 1: List of everything you have done this year
 - Ex: Attending meetings, workshops, and camps
- -Page 2: List of everything you have done this year outside of 4-H
 - Ex: At your home, in school, and in your community
- -Page 3: List of all the projects you are completing full records on. Second half of the page, is all the other projects you have been doing, just not applying for a complete record project award
- -Page 4: A story of how this past year went
 - Ex: How you felt, what you enjoyed, what you want to do next year, etc.
- -Additional: Add photos and newspaper clippings that show's your club and project involvement.



Project Records: Individual project areas

- -Beginning of the year goals
- -During the year: Action plan: everything you did with the project
- -What did you learn?
- -Communication: Did you do a presentation or share your knowledge?
- -End of year reflections: Overall experience, plan to continue next year?
- -Livestock/photography/horticulture forms: Species specific forms
- -Supporting materials: pictures(labeled), write-ups, newspaper clippings

- -Make sure you have answered all the questions related to the project and awards you are applying for.

Clover Kids

The registration for the 2022-2023 4-H year for Clover Kids is now open! Programming will begin in October!

What is Clover Kids?:

Clover Kids is a fun 4-H program specifically designed for children in kindergarten through third grade. The overall purpose of the lowa 4-H Clover Kids program is to foster the development of life skills that are essential for the cognitive, social, emotional, and physical maturation of kindergarten through third graders by providing a unique, age-appropriate educational opportunity. In order to provide a high quality learning experience, the Clover Kids program is designed to be continuous and long-term. For this reason, Clover Kids groups meet on a regular basis (x1 per month).

What do Clover Kids do?:

Investigate Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM), explore literacy through fun and engaging ways to read and write, learn the importance of being healthy and physically active, practice communication skills and learn to work as a team, play fun cooperative games and make new friends, participate in developmentally appropriate opportunities at County Fair, and much, much more!!

How can my child become a Clover Kid?:

Afterschool Clover Kid registration forms will be available at the Poweshiek County Extension Office or the School Offices at Montezuma Elementary, Baily Park Elementary, Fairview Elementary, and BGM Elementary schools. 


