ANIMAL INFORMATION

YQCA

For 2020: All 4-H livestock Exhibitors will be required to be YQCA certified for county and State Fair for the following: Beef, Dairy Cattle/ Dairy Goat, Meat Goat, Poultry, Rabbit, Sheep and Swine.

The cost is **\$12 per test**, with test out options for first year intermediates and seniors. You will not be charge the fee until you pass your test. Financial assistance is available- please contact our Extension Office if needed.

County Fair Entries Due June 15th

After identifying your animals in 4honline by May 15, you will need to confirm what animals you are bringing to Poweshiek County Fair. Poweshiek County Fair entries are due June 15! Entry forms can be downloaded at www.poweshiekcountyfair.org. Fill out the form(s) and return them to the PoweshiekCounty Fair Office in Grinnell (not the Extension Office). Please include the following fees:

- * \$5 late fee per division entered (*accepted until July 1*)
- * Please wait to send in bedding money until we know for sure how fair will look.

State Fair Entries Due July 1st

State Fair livestock and horticulture entries are due July 1st through the Fair Entry program.
