In general, it is highly suggested that exhibits be presented without frosting unless the frosting is part of the exhibit goal. If frosting is part of the goal, this <u>blog post</u> contains the ONLY approved recipe for homemade frosting that can be used.

Exhibitors can

also use commercially prepared, shelf-stable, purchased frosting in their exhibit.
