Information	Program Description
Kindergarten-5th Grade	"Discover Asia" is a curriculum designed to introduce students to various countries, cultures and customs, throughout the continent of Asia.
Curriculum Format	Each lesson can be presented in 45-60 minutes. Teaching Guide with complete instructions is provided. Teaching Kit with materials needed to present lessons is provided. User may need to provide standard classroom supplies (pencils, scissors, glue). If a lesson requires perishable items (e.g. milk), user

Lesson	Overview
One: China	Students will learn various facts about China, practice writing Chinese characters, and do Tangram puzzles.
Two: Japan	Students will learn various facts about Japan, read A Carp for Kimiko and make a carp streamer for Japan's "Children's Day."
Three: Korea	Students will learn the history of Korean kite making and create a Korean kite of their own.
Four: India	Students will learn various facts about India, practice simple yoga, and work on solving math puzzles that originated in India.
Five: Vietnam	Students will learn about the Vietnamese New Year celebration, Tet, create a paper dragon for Tet, and play "Pov Pob," a Hmong ball-toss game.
