Iowa Farm Bureau Scholarships

To apply for these scholarships, you only need to submit *one* application which will enter you for a chance to receive the state *and* local Farm Bureau scholarships available to you. Mary Paul 4-H Scholarship

Qualifications

- ⇒ Applicant must plan to attend ISU in the fall that this scholarship is awarded
- ⇒ Applicant must be a permanent resident of Muscatine or Scott county.
- ⇒ Applicant must be a college freshman in the semester the scholarship is awarded. Click here to apply.

You will receive your birds sometime in March-April

Rules and Requirements:

- Must be a first time poultry exhibitor and enter poultry in the 2023 Mississippi Valley Fair Poultry Show.
- Must be an active member and in good standing with your 4H or FFA club (4th-12th grades)
- Invest \$25 dollars to the Mississippi Valley Poultry Producers. Once you have entered and showed your poultry at the Mississippi Valley Poultry Show, your \$25 will be refunded back to you.
- If for any reason you do not show your \$25 will be forfeited.

We will have a meeting/workshop on March 19th starting at 1pm at the ISU Scott County Extension Office. You must attend with a parent or guardian.

- Registration deadline March 15th. Payment is due before or at the March 19th meeting
- Make check payable to Mississippi Valley Poultry Producers.


