Frequently Asked Questions about Curriculum and Kits

- O. Can we view curriculum and kits?
- A. Yes. Call Jen at the Scott County Extension office (563-359-7577) or email her at jbest@iastate.edu to set up an appointment to preview curriculum or kits.
- Q. How long can we borrow curriculum and kits?
- A. One month.
- Q. Do we teach the lessons or do you have staff that teach them?
- A. Typically, teachers borrow and present their own lessons. In some situations, we may have a staff member available to present lessons for a fee. Call Jen at the Scott County Extension office (563-359-7577) or email her at jbest@iastate.edu for more information.
- Q. Do the kits come with all the supplies needed to deliver the lessons?
- A. Usually, yes. However, some curriculum and kits require perishable items (like milk or fruit) that may need to be purchased by the user.
- Q. Do I have to replenish the items in the kit before I bring them back?
- A. No. Scott County Extension incurs the cost of replenishing the kits. The user is responsible for the replacement costs of nonconsumable items (such as science equipment) that are broken during use. Users will sign an agreement of use statement when they check out their kit.
