Description: "Going Places, Making Choices" addresses the relationship between transportation and environmental issues. It has five units with activities and information on the following topics:

- The History of Transportation
- Natural Resources
- Air Pollution and Climate
- Land Use
- Personal Choice and Action

This curriculum encourages teens to apply wisdom, ingenuity, and sound science to the choices they make.

Format: The curriculum is set up in five units that can be taught individually or together. A resource and reference guide is also included.
