




Scott County 4-H Day of Giving

Register for the 2023-2024 Year in 4-H!

- Log into 4-H Online to re enroll.
- Use the same username and password as last year
- Returning members may enroll until December 1, 2023
- New members may enroll until May 15, 2024
- Scott County Extension is unable to accept late enrollments and/or late payments

Note: lowa State has increased the 4–H Club enrollment fee to \$45. These fees cover resource development and supplies at the state level, state level salaries, and the \$5.4–H Online fee. Scott County 4–H does not receive any of the funds.

Clover Kids fee is still \$10.



Youth Well-Being: Growth Mindset

The 4-H Thrive Model of Positive Youth Development is illustrated below. The concept of growth mindset is included on the stem of the diagram. A growth mindset (as opposed to a fixed mindset) is the belief that intelligence, talents, and abilities can be developed. Young people with this belief have an increased interest in learning, embracing challenges, persisting in the face of setbacks, learning from criticism, and finding inspiration in the success of others.

Developing these qualities is built into 4–H. We encourage the growth mindset in our young people when we praise their processes of learning: their effort, their focus, their perseverance, and their improvement.
