Information	Program Description
Kindergarten-3rd Grade	Students learn about the history of the agriculture and how we get the food we eat today. The curriculum focuses on foods that are commonly used in households and are also found in ice cream.
Curriculum Format	Teaching Guide with complete instructions is provided. Teaching Kit with materials needed to present lessons is provided. User may need to provide standard classroom supplies (pencils, scissors, glue). If a lesson requires perishable items (e.g. milk), user is responsible for these purchases.

Lesson	Overview
Rocks to Ice Cream is one lesson that can be facilitated in one hour.	Students learn the basic steps of agricultural history through the use of pictures, signs and story telling. Students focus on ice cream and how each ingredient reaches grocery stores. Students make ice cream using these ingredients.
