#### 2023 Mississippi Valley Fair Exhibits Increased by 11%

The number of 4–H Club members stayed the same at 279 while the number of exhibits increased from 2,477 in 2022 to 2,753 in 2023. Thank you for all of your hard work this year!

#### 4-H Club Re-Enrollment Is Now Open

It's time to register for the 2023-2024 Year in 4-H!

- Log into 4-H Online to re enroll.
- Use the same username and password as last year
- Returning members may enroll until December 1, 2023
- New members may enroll until May 15, 2024
- Scott County Extension is unable to accept late enrollments and/or late payments

Note: Iowa State has increased the 4–H Club enrollment fee to \$45. These fees cover resource development and supplies at the state level, state level salaries, and the \$5 4–H Online fee. Scott County 4–H does not receive any of the funds. The Clover Kids fee is still \$10.
