



Sioux County Youth Fair Information for 2023-24 Clover Kids

Sioux County Clover Kids are invited to participate at the 2024 Sioux County Youth Fair.

Clover Kids can exhibit static exhibits or pets.

Dates and times will be announced in the spring, but information about each project area is available here.

Static Exhibit Judging Day

Date: Friday, July 12, 2024

Time: 1:00 p.m.

Location: ISU Extension and Outreach (downstairs) Come through East Entrance

Clover Kids can bring up to 10 projects to the 4-H Static Exhibit Judging Day. No pre-fair entry is required for Clover Kids. This is VERY informal, but a great learning experience.

Clover Kids may have static exhibits in any of these classes:

- **Class A:** Creative Arts – items related to art, photography, or music.
- **Class B:** Agriculture and Natural Resources – items related to plants, agriculture, or the environment.
- **Class C:** Family and Consumer Science – items related to food, clothing, or home decorating.
- **Class D:** Personal Development – items related to, or created by the child, such as stories, poems, etc.
- **Class E:** Science, Engineering, and Technology – items related to science, engineering, technology, or items designed and built by the child.
- **Class F:** Other – items not included under any of the above classes.

Guidelines:

- Attach a Clover Kids Static Exhibit Goal Card to each project. These are available on our website: www.extension.iastate.edu/sioux/clover-kids
- Make sure each piece of a project is labeled with first and last name.

Other Information:

- Participating should only take 15 to 30 minutes.
- All participants will receive a Clover Kids ribbon.
- Projects will be displayed in the Clover Kids booth in the 4-H Exhibit Building during the week of the Sioux County Fair.
- After projects are judged, they will need to be brought to the Sioux County Fair grounds and picked up from the Clover Kids booth during the designated time at the end of fair.
- Please note that projects will be displayed in a high-traffic, public building. Our office is not responsible for missing or damaged projects.

Pet Show

Date: Monday, July 15, 2024

Time: 4-H Pet Show starts at 4:00 p.m. Clover Kids Pet Show will follow.

Location: Show Arena at the Sioux County Fairgrounds

Clover Kids may bring 1 pet.

No pre-fair entry is required for Clover Kids. This is VERY informal, but a great learning experience.

Clover Kids may show animals in the following classes:

- **Class A:** Cats
- **Class B:** Fish
- **Class C:** Birds
- **Class D:** Dogs
- **Class E:** Rabbits
- **Class F:** Pocket Pets (hamsters, guinea pigs, ferrets, chinchillas, etc.)
- **Class G:** Bottle/ Bucket Calves (animals must be less than 200 pounds to be shown in the pet show)
- **Class H:** Bottle Lambs or Goats
- **Class I:** Other

No turtles, snakes, rats, mice, wildlife or livestock such as swine, horses, or cattle will be accepted.

Guidelines:

- Please complete the Clover Kids Pet Show goal card and bring to the show along with your animal. Goal cards are available on our website: www.extension.iastate.edu/sioux/clover-kids
 - The pet must be clean and able to be handled with minimal assistance. All pets must be caged, leashed, and/or contained as appropriate.
 - Clover Kids will show the audience their pet and tell a caring adult about their pet while in the Show Arena.
 - Clover Kids and pets must be supervised by an adult at all times. The adult is responsible for both the Clover Kid and pet. These pets are only allowed on the fairgrounds during the entry and time of show.
